

The Sutherland Astronomical Society Practical Astronomy

Course (SASPAC) is held annually at the Green Point Observatory and runs on **Wednesday evenings** for 9 weekly sessions. Recommended for adults, teens and gifted sub-teens who wish to expand their knowledge of the cosmos.

The material covered in this course will engage both beginner and experienced astronomer alike. No prior knowledge of astronomy is required. **9 week course**
